#### **Waiver Amendments**



## Anticipated implementation November 2023

- Specialty Telehealth and Assessment Teams
- Assistive Technology/Remote Supports Equipment and Technology
- Supported Employment
- Addition of NG 5
- Group Music, Art, & Equine therapy

#### **Public Comment Process/Submission**



- Public comment ended on June 27<sup>th</sup>.
  - ODP received over 500 comments from 33 stakeholders (individuals and organizations)



Waivers submitted to CMS on July 25.

# **Specialty Telehealth and Assessment Team (STAT)**



- The goal of the Specialty Telehealth and Assessment Team service is to provide a **right-on-time telehealth assessment**.
- Available when the participant's primary care physician is unavailable or unable to determine the best clinical course of action
- This service can promote better health outcomes and avoid unnecessary emergency room visits.

## **Assistive Technology Changes**



Purchasing, leasing, or otherwise providing for the acquisition of assistive technology devices for the participant. Leasing of equipment and devices is only allowable short term:

- For emergency substitution of a device or equipment until repairs are made or a replacement can be purchased; or
- To allow a participant to try equipment and device(s) to determine whether the equipment or device(s) will be a good fit for the participant's needs.

# **Enhanced Levels of Service: Provider Qualifications**



The following change applies to enhanced levels of service in Community Participation Support, In-Home and Community Support, and respite:

At least one staff person must have one of the following certifications or degrees to provide enhanced levels of service to participants who do not require a nurse to provide the enhanced level of service:

 Bachelor's Degree or higher in Psychology, Education, Special Education, Counseling, Social Work, Gerontology or Therapeutic Recreation.

## **Needs Group 5 (NG5)**

- Effective January 1, 2024 existing exceptional residential rates will transition to NG5 Fee Schedule
- Sufficient historical data exists on exceptional rate process and individuals to reduce administrative burden for providers and ODP
- There will continue to be an exceptional rate request process for individuals whose needs exceed NG5:
  - Individuals must have a current HRST
  - Service Location must have at least 6 months of historical cost information with the individual(s)

## Music, Art and Equine Therapy



- Based on public comment, added a group option
- Therapy services consist of the following individual and group therapies for no more than 4 individuals that are not primarily recreational or diversionary:
  - Art Therapy;
  - Music Therapy; and
  - Equine Assisted Therapy

### **ARPA Supplemental Payments**



- Supplemental Payments for Recovery & Service Expansion: Community Participation Supports
- Tiered one-time supplemental payments will be available based on provider recovery or expansion status as of June 2023 in the following amounts:

Standard for payment eligibility	Payment Amount Per Individual Receivin g CPS
Providers exceeding pre-pandemic service capacity*	\$2500
Providers achieving 75-100% of pre-pandemic capacity	\$1500
Providers achieving 50-75% of pre-pandemic capacity	\$1000
Providers achieving under 50% of pre-pandemic capacity	\$ 500

• \*Provider recovery or expansion status is determined by comparing the provider's pre-pandemic number of program participants (discrete participants in service during FY 2019/2020 with the number of participants in service during FY 2022/2023)

## **Community Participation Support**



Removed <u>individual variance process</u> in favor of a process to address more systemic community integration.

- Service locations with more than 10% of individuals spending less than 25% of their time in community settings on average...
- are required...
- ...to describe strategies for improvement within the provider's Quality Management Plan (6100.45).
