The Office of Developmental Programs is pursuing Selective Contracting for residential and supports coordination providers in an effort to enhance services and outcomes. Selective Contracting will also establish tiered rates and a preferred provider status, which will ultimately limit the number of providers that ODP will contract with for these services in the future
